# **INTRODUCTION:** Background

- Poor communication across disciplines and organizations increases the risk of patient harm<sup>1</sup>.
- University Medical Center- New • Orleans (UMCNO) is challenged with communication and alignment as a young academic medical center hosting two schools (Louisiana State University and Tulane University).
- Case-based patient safety conferences have historically been successful tools for such communication<sup>2</sup>; however, some adjustments are needed.

# RESULTS

### General

- 10 SHIP conferences to date
- Average attendance: 134 (77-222)
- 70% physicians + nurses
- 15 hospital-wide interventions now in place as a result of the conference.

## **Post Conference Evaluations**

- Post conference evaluation rate average 52%
- 90% of respondents agree that discussions were solutions-based rather than blame oriented
- 92% of respondents report helpful insights from other disciplines


