In Memoriam: Les Sandlow, MD

The Alliance was saddened to learn of the passing of Leslie Sandlow, MD, on July 26th. He was 87 years old. Dr. Sandlow was one of the first medical education leaders to join AIAMC Founder Dr. Ethel Weinberg in her quest for national recognition of independent academic medical centers. In 1989 when the AIAMC was formed, Dr. Sandlow established the education unit at Michael Reese Hospital and Medical Center in Chicago. He went on to serve in numerous leadership roles at the University of Illinois College of Medicine before retiring in 2010. Dr. Sandlow is survived by his wife of 64 years, Joanne, their three children, and eight grandchildren. The AIAMC has made a donation to the *Dr. Les and Joanne Sandlow Scholarship for Health Care Education at the Milwaukee Academy of Science*.
