


Since Launch – Downloads by Region


Future Plans

Requirements (those with an asterisk are pending)


- Publish peer-reviewed content
- Publication must have an ISSN
- Article titles and abstracts should be in English
- Published for at least 12 months
- Published a total of at least 40 primary articles *
- Evidence of a regular publication schédule *
- Publication is a collection of articles by different authors
- Content is issued over time under a common title
- Publication is intended to be published indefinitely
- Provide XML-tagged citation and abstract data *
- Have an acceptable arrangement for permanent preservation of, and access to, the content
- References in Roman script
- Publication ethics/publication malpractice statement *




